

Robert Bredin

Born: c.1772
President: 1822-1923
Died: Unknown

Robert Bredin was born in Dublin about 1772. His father, Jerome, was a merchant in the city. Bredin was admitted to Trinity College on 27 September 1788 as a pupil pensioner. He had been educated by a Mr Miller, and his tutor was Mr Burrows. He was awarded his BA from Trinity College in 1793. He then obtained his MD from the University of Edinburgh in 1808 with the title of his dissertation being *De Ascites*.

Bredin was admitted a Licentiate of the College of Physicians in 1809. He received his Fellowship of the College in January 1813 and was elected President in 1822. No other records of his professional life could be traced.
